Synopsis:

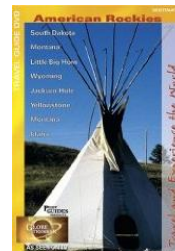

Synopsis:

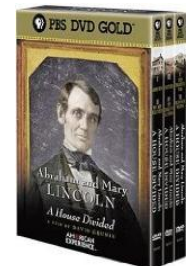
